VISA FOR MALTA

1.0 TO APPLY FOR A VISA FOR MALTA:

- 1.1 The following are sent for each person by e-mail to maltaconsulate@intekom.co.za or by fax to 011 706 0301:
- a) Completed application form (now comprising 4 pages);
 - b) Copy of passport, sent preferably by e-mail, which CLEARLY shows the photograph and passport number;
 - c) Copy of invitation with name and contact number in Malta should the applicant be going on business;
 - d) Copy of deposit slip for a non-refundable R150.00 application fee. Banking details are ABSA Bank, Branch No. 509955, Account No. 90-8685-4086, for 'The Consulate of Malta'. Give the applicant's name in the reference block on the deposit slip. To confirm that the account is in the name of the Consulate, kindly ask the ABSA Teller to refer to the 'Basic Transaction Screen'.
- 1.2 The application is processed by the Consulate and forwarded to the Malta Immigration Dept. for consideration;
- 1.3 If approved, a Visa Certificate is faxed to this Consulate, which is then faxed to the applicant or their agent;
- 1.4 If refused, the refusal notice is faxed to the applicant or their agent;
- 1.5 When a Visa Certificate is issued, the applicant must travel with it as proof that a visa has been granted;
- 1.6 On arrival in Malta, the Visa Certificate is presented to the Passport Control Officer with the passport, 2 passport photographs, and Lm10.00 (about R200.00). Euros, US dollars or British Pound Sterling may be changed at the airport for local currency while the visa is being prepared.

2.0 PLEASE NOTE:

- 2.1 Include a copy of that page of the passport with the passport number shown;
- 2.2 Forward applications to this Consulate eighteen (18) working days before the applicant's date of departure;
- 2.3 Please be advised that The Malta Authorities do NOT issue multiple visas. A visa has to be obtained for each entry;
- 2.4 Note that visas are issued at the discretion of the Maltese Authorities only, and not by this Consulate;
- 2.5 Ensure that a return fax and contact telephone number is given on the application form or in a covering letter;
- 2.6 Be aware that applicants coming from countries listed as "infected areas" as identified by the World Health Organization must carry the necessary vaccination certificates. The travel agent will assist in this regard;
- 2.7 Access the web site at www.gov.mt for further details about visa requirements. You may also obtain a Visa Form;

TO AVOID DELAYS, PLEASE ENSURE THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS GIVEN.

3.0 SHENGEN VISAS:

- 3.1 Shengen Visas valid in Shengen States are now accepted for multiple entries into Malta. You do not need a Malta visa should you be granted a Shengen Visa.
